Organ Update

As of Sunday, June 23rd, all of the pipes are now in the organhooray! On to the next step: voicing. The voicers, Aaron and Joel, arrived on Monday to begin the voicing process. This is the period that takes 6-8 weeks. The instrument will not look different or change its appearance during this time. During voicing, you'll often hear Aaron and Joel playing a single note over and overthis is part of the process, and just as a warning, listening for too long can grate on one's nerves a bit. Anyone is welcome to come into the nave during this time and hear the process as it happens, however you've been forewarned and may end up not wanting to stay in there for too long!

One more note about the voicing process... Once a stop is finished being voiced, that means it's ready to be played! I will therefore plan to start playing single stops in church on Sundays as they are completed that week, starting this Sunday. The organ is considered fully installed once the voicing is completely finished. Enjoy these next summer Sundays hearing the beautiful sounds of the organ gradually emerge from the loft!

MUSIC TALKS

The next talk in the series is entitled **Time Perception in Music** and will take place today. This session will build slightly on the previous one but look further into considering time perception in music. This topic explores how our perception of time is manipulated through a musical listening experience and what implications this has both musically and temporally. Points covered include research on time perception, the effects of music tempo and rhythm (or lack thereof), and the many other ways in which a musical experience can shape our perception of time passing. Several pieces of music will be used as case studies in this talk, including Bach's Aria from the Goldberg Variations, Chopin's "Minute" Waltz, and select passages from 20th century minimalist and/or ambient composers.
