- Kip and Amanda led a review of Chapter 2 of the Vestry Resource Guide.
- February Vestry meeting minutes were approved as presented.
- Bob Emory gave a report from the Sacred Sound and Space Committee, with updates from the listening sessions and future plans.
 - * Taylor & Booty Organ Builders will be at the church to assess acoustical enhancements required before any possible installation.
 - * If there is to be a Sacred Sound and Space capital campaign, the Vestry approved tithing 10% of the proceeds to outreach.

- The 2019 budget was reviewed; some final tweaking to be done.
- A Vestry, Staff and Commission Head meeting was scheduled for 6:30 p.m., March 25.

- Ashley announced that she has chosen to attend Sewanee.
- Commission liaisons made reports from the various commissions.
- Meeting was adjourned at 8:50 p.m.
