Thursday's Devotion

Galatians 3: 26-28

So, in Christ Jesus you are all children of God through faith, for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Christ Jesus. If you belong to Christ, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.

We are all the children of God. No matter what the color of our skin is, what gender we are, none of that matters to God, so it should not matter to us. We are commanded by God to be different, we are supposed to feel like strangers in this world. Satan wants you to be divided, for there to be tension and stress between God's people, and for there to be constant hatred and bitterness because that is how Satan separates you from God. If Satan wants us to be divided then we must unify, if Satan wants there to be tension and stress then we must seek peace, and if Satan wants hatred and bitterness then we have to love our neighbor, even love our enemy because that is what God desires from us.

1. What does the word "unity" mean to you?
2. Think of a group of people that are showing "unity" in the world today, whether you've seen it on the news, seen it on the internet, or heard someone speak about them. What is it about that group that shows "unity"?
3. When we are at camp, what are some ways that we can show "unity" as a cabin or as a camp in general?
4. What does "unity" mean to God, why does God want us to be unified as Christians in this sinful world that seems to want us to be divided by hate, jealousy, and anger?
